## SUNY FREDONIA Faculty Student Association Overview

The Fredonia Faculty Student Association (FSA), incorporated in 1951, is a private corporation governed by the Not-for-Profit Corporation Laws of the State of New York. The bylaws of the corporation detail the purpose, membership, meeting requirement, director responsibilities and specification for the corporation assets and funds. The board of directors consists of five constituent groups represented as follows: (7) Students, (3) Faculty, (3) Administrative Staff, (1) Classified Staff, and (1) Alumni Representative, for a total of (15) directors.

The mission of the Faculty Student Association is to identify and provide appropriate goods and services that may not be otherwise provided by the State of New York. Central to the effort is the ability to recognize the variety and dynamic nature of the population involved in an attempt to maximize customer satisfaction while maintaining the financial integrity of the corporation.

SUNY Auxiliary Services Corporations individually hold Contract Agreements with their respective institutions as specified by Guidelines with the State University of New York.
