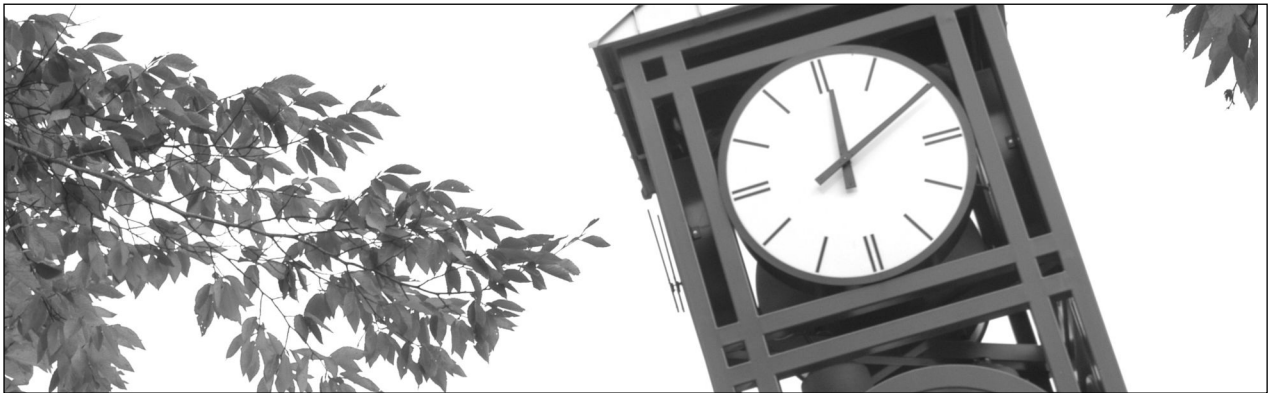

The Spring into Fredonia Program...

During this program, you will meet with a faculty member in your major department and register for your fall classes.

The schedule is as follows:

8:30 a.m. ----- Program Registration

9:00 a.m. ----- Program begins McEwen 209

Once your advisement and registration is complete you can go to the Faculty Student Association (FSA) office and get your Fredonia ID card and information on the various dining accounts. Upon receipt of your ID card, you will receive a \$7.00 voucher towards lunch.

Reservations are limited and will be taken on a space available basis by major. We need to receive your deposit by April 15th for your participation in this program. Your deposit is \$50 if you plan to live off-campus or \$100 if you plan to live on-campus. Please complete the enclosed reservation form and return it with your deposit in the enclosed envelope.
