

Getting Started with ANGEL

The ANGEL Learning Management System is available to the SUNY Fredonia campus & community members for use in courses and groups. The system can be accessed via the ANGEL link on the home page (under e-Services) or directly via this URL:

ANGEL uses the e-Services username and password that can be found in Your Connection. Detailed login instructions are posted via a link on the ANGEL home page.

- Courses will be loaded from Banner data.
- When courses are loaded, they will be visible or “available.”
- Students will be enrolled in ANGEL courses automatically.
- If your courses do not appear on your My Page please check with your department to be sure you are the assigned instructor.

- When users attend Introduction to ANGEL Training, they are added to the ANGEL User Group where they can receive system information emails, participate in discussions, and get upcoming ANGEL training notifications and access reference materials. - Students are added to the ANGEL Student Group to receive similar information.
