Foreign Language Equivalency -6 credit hours</b> BA students must demonstrate a language proficiency at the 116 level or beyond; all other students must demonstrate a language proficiency at the 115 level. Students in professional programs should consult their advisors for program specific details. To demonstrate proficiency, all students may do one of the following: <b>a)</b> score 85 or higher on a NYS Regents Foreign Language Exam, <b>b)</b> complete the externally-administered standardized test for foreign language of either the AP (3 or higher) or CLEP (50th percentile or higher), <b>c)</b> have native fluency, <b>d)</b> study abroad (and submit a Course Appeal/Substitution request to the General Education Office), <b>e)</b> successfully complete a 3 to 6 credit course at SUNY Fredonia in this category at the appropriate level (115 or 116 or 120/121).
