Advice & Notes:

- **Course frequencies:** Of the above courses, only the following are offered every academic year: Anth 331, Inds 120, Phil 238, Psy 291. The other courses are offered less often, so you should jump at the chance to take them, especially if you are a junior or senior.
- **Prerequisites:**
 - Anth 331 prerequisite: Anth 115 or Soc 116 or Hist 105 or Hist 106.
 - Hist 355 prerequisite: Hist 105, 106, 133, or Inds 120.
 - Hist 389, 398, or 399 prerequisite: Hist 101, 102, 115, 116, 134, or Inds 120
 - All 300 and 400 level Philosophy courses above have as a prerequisite either Inds 120 or one other course in Philosophy.
