

## Religious Studies minor requirements & electives

### Required course:

INDS 120 World Religions [Intro to Religious Studies and survey of Hinduism, Buddhism, Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. This is also a Gen Ed World History or Non-Western Civilization course.] (B)

**Elective courses:** Five courses selected from the following list of 3-credit courses. At least 6 credit hours must be at the 300-level or above. Not all electives may be taken within a single discipline:
