**Dear EDP Students:**

**1 - TUTORING** - We are already ending the **sixth** week of the semester. **Mid-semester is October 21.** If you are experiencing any academic difficulty or want to reinforce what you are learning, fill out a request for a tutor **TODAY.** Don't wait. REMEMBER: Once you are assigned a tutor, your notification will be sent via e-mail. Tutors are in demand, and EDP students are not the only students requesting assigned tutoring. Finding tutors in your requested area and matching available time slots is time consuming. You can also go for drop-in tutoring at the Learning Center, 4<sup>th</sup> floor of Reed Library.
