

Inserting a Link in ANGEL

Creating a link in ANGEL is a good way to share web resources with students

1. Go to the Lessons tab
2. Click on Add Content
3. Click the Link option
4. In the Title field enter the name of the page the students will be directed to
5. In the Link URL field, enter the address of the website
 - a. This address must include the http: or https: and all of the other coding in the address. It is recommended that you locate the website and copy the link from the browser then paste it into ANGEL.
6. Change the Link Target window from Same Window to New Window and checkmark No Banner
7. Press Save
