

## Using Originality Reports from Turnitin.com

After students submit a paper an Originality Report is produced. This report will show if there are any similarities to other works. The report will show how much similarity there is, and where it came from. The first time a paper is submitted the report will be generated immediately. Subsequent submissions of the same paper will take 24 hours to create the Originality Report. Below are some tips on how to use this report.

### To see the reports:

1. Log in to Turnitin.com
2. Click on the class name
3. Click on the inbox icon



Looking at the inbox you will be able to see the percentage of similarity on each paper.

To view the similarities and their sources click on the report percentage results. This will open the paper, divided into sections, based on non-original matches. Not all similarities are plagiarism. Some matches may be properly cited quotes or results from the bibliography. You can exclude these items from the results by selecting the links at the top of an individual paper's result screen.
