Some examples include...

- **Combined Recycling:** Gone are the days of sifting and sorting! With over 1,500 receptacles located campus-wide where items can be placed in a one-stop container, we've made it easier than ever for everyone to chip in.
- **Earth Week:** For the second-straight year, SUNY Fredonia has produced a week-long series of presentations and events to discuss, study, promote and instill ways that we can all reduce, reuse and recycle.
- **Biodegradable Maintenance Products:** One example is "Ice B'Gone," a street and sidewalk de-icing material which is far friendlier to the environment, not to mention people's clothing, cars and other belongings.
- **RecycleMania:** A world-wide contest in which college campuses compete to recycle the most pounds of materials. SUNY Fredonia has competed in each of the last two years, generating close to 150,000 pounds of materials in the process.
- **Communications:** Whether through online newsletters, listserv messages or ads like this one, we steadily remind our campus community about ways we can all save energy and resources with even relatively easy and subtle lifestyle changes.
