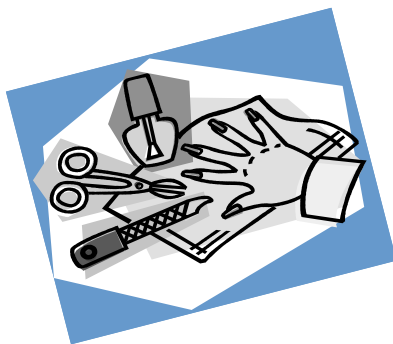

## Basic Interviewing Tips

- Dress professionally for an interview even if you know the environment is casual
- Keep cologne/perfume to a minimum
- Cover up tattoos and remove body jewelry until you know whether they are acceptable at that particular workplace
- Make-up and jewelry should be tasteful and simple.
- Carefully inspect your clothes for tags, loose threads and missing buttons
- Shoes (not sneakers) should be clean and in good condition
- Hair should be neatly styled, facial hair trimmed, and nails clean
- **NOTE: Jeans ARE NEVER acceptable interview attire!**
