HIGHLIGHTS THIS YEAR ...

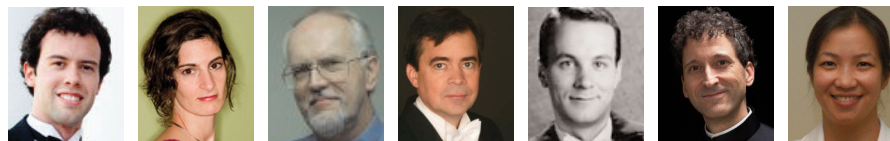
