ARRIVAL INSTRUCTIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION FOR RETURNING STUDENTS FOR FALL 2009

RESIDENCE HALLS - Residence Life will be prepared to check in returning students beginning Saturday, August 22 from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., and Sunday August 23, after 9:00 a.m. Please be aware you will not be able to arrive prior to the dates indicated. If you have any questions regarding your arrival, please contact the Residence Life Office (716) 673-3341. Just a reminder -- please be prepared to pay \$20 hall dues upon arrival.

ID CARDS - ID cards (FREDCards) will be processed at the FSA office, 1st floor, Gregory Hall, beginning on Saturday, August 22 from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sunday, August 23 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and continuing throughout the week.

MEAL PLAN PARTICIPANTS - Students who have selected meal plans 2-4 will receive two meals on Saturday, August 22. All other plans begin Saturday, August 22. Normal weekly meal plans begin with brunch on Sunday, August 23. Cranston Marche will be open August 22 and 23 for brunch and lunch from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and for dinner from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Centre Pointe will be open August 22 and 23 from 11:00 a.m. to Midnight. The Campus Grind in the Williams Center will be open Saturday and Sunday from Noon to 11:00 p.m. Regular dining service hours resume on Monday, August 24.

BOOKSTORE - The Bookstore is located in University Commons and is where you can find textbooks and course materials as well as a variety of personal care items, clothing, gifts, and snacks. Normal operating hours for the Bookstore are Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Bookstore offers extended hours at the beginning of each semester for your convenience. *The Bookstore and pre-pack area in University Commons will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 22 and Sunday, August 23.*

CONVENIENCE STORE - Open August 22 and August 23 from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Normal hours will resume on Monday, August 24.

STARBUCKS - Open August 22 from 7:30 a.m. to 1:00 a.m., and August 23 from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Normal hours will resume on Monday, August 24.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - Payment in full of all university charges, less approved financial aid, must be made by August 15, 2009. Payments made after this date will be assessed a \$30 Administrative fee for a balance due of \$30 or more.
