RESIDENCE HALL STUDENTS - PLEASE REPORT TO YOUR ASSIGNED RESIDENCE HALL.

Residence Halls open for all students beginning Saturday, August 20 from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. and Sunday, August 21, after 9:00 a.m. Please be aware you will not be able to arrive prior to the dates indicated. If you have any questions regarding your arrival, please contact the Residence Life Office at (716) 673-3341. Just a reminder - please be prepared to pay the optional \$20 hall dues upon arrival. Students living on campus, but not assigned to a residence hall, should report to the Office of Residence Life, 1st floor, Gregory Hall. The office will be open Saturday, August 20 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on Sunday, August 21 from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm.

WHAT TO BRING - only what you need! Small microwaves and refrigerators are allowed in the residence halls. You may wish to bring a radio, TV, or stereo; however, due to limited space in rooms it is advisable to coordinate this with your roommate (if possible). You should bring a supply of towels, washcloths, blankets, a pillow, and bedspread or you may wish to purchase these items locally. Containers for soiled clothes, soap, and toothbrush may be needed. Additional lighting (desk lamp) may be necessary and storage containers are useful.

ID CARDS - ID cards (FREDCards) will be processed at the FSA office, 1st floor, Gregory Hall, beginning on Saturday, August 20, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Sunday, August 21 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and continuing throughout the week.

MEAL PLAN PARTICIPANTS - All Meal Plans begin Saturday, August 20, 2011. Students who have selected Meal Plan #1, #2, & #3 and #5 will receive two (2) meals for Saturday, August 20th. **CRANSTON MARCHE**, University Commons, will be open Saturday, August 20 and Sunday, August 21 for breakfast/brunch/lunch from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and for dinner from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. **CENTRE POINTE**, Williams Center, will be open Saturday, August 20 and Sunday, August 21 from 11:00 a.m. to Midnight. Regular dining service hours resume on Monday, August 22.

BOOKSTORE, University Commons - The Bookstore offers textbooks, course materials, as well as a variety of personal care items, clothing, gifts, and snacks. Normal operating hours for the Bookstore are Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Bookstore offers extended hours at the beginning of each semester for your convenience. *The Bookstore and pre-pack area in University Commons will be open from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturday, August 20 and Sunday, August 21.*

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION - ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REGISTERED WITHIN SEVEN (7) DAYS after classes begin. Registration will take place during the week of Monday, August 22, from 9:00 am. - 4:30 pm in the University Commons, Lobby area. Bring your FREDCard. All vehicles must be registered before August 29, 2011.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - Payment in full of all university charges, less approved financial aid, must be made by the due date on your semester eBill.
