## ARRIVAL INSTRUCTIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION FOR RETURNING STUDENTS FOR FALL 2011

**PARKING** - Please note that some road closures and traffic patterns have changed on-campus due to construction, for an updated map, visit [www.fredonia.edu/movein](http://www.fredonia.edu/movein).

**RESIDENCE HALLS** - Residence Halls open for all students beginning Saturday, August 20 from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., and Sunday August 21, after 9:00 a.m. Please be aware you will not be able to arrive prior to the dates indicated. If you have any questions regarding your arrival, please contact the Residence Life Office (716) 673-3341. Just a reminder -- please be prepared to pay the optional \$20 hall dues upon arrival.

**RESNET** - The ResNet Office is an Information Technology helpdesk that provides services and support for students, staff and guests living in the residence halls. ResNet provides customer service through the use of telephone, email, and face-to-face assistance to students, staff and guests living in SUNY Fredonia residence halls with information technology related items. **ID CARDS** - ID cards (FREDCards) will be processed at the FSA office, 1<sup>st</sup> floor, Gregory Hall, beginning on Saturday, August 20 from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sunday, August 21 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and continuing throughout the week.

**MEAL PLAN PARTICIPANTS** - All Meal Plans begin Saturday, August 20, 2011. Students who have selected Meal Plan #1, #2, #3 & #5 will receive two (2) meals for Saturday, August 20<sup>th</sup>. **CRANSTON MARCHE**, University Commons, will be open Saturday, August 20 and Sunday, August 21 for breakfast/brunch/lunch from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and for dinner from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. **CENTRE POINTE**, Williams Center, will be open Saturday, August 20 and Sunday, August 21 from 11:00 a.m. to Midnight. Regular dining service hours resume on Monday, August 22.

**BOOKSTORE, University Commons** - The Bookstore offers textbooks, course materials, as well as a variety of personal care items, clothing, gifts, and snacks. **IMPORTANT NOTICE** - Payment in full of all university charges, less approved financial aid, must be made by the due date on your semester eBill. You may view your eBill by clicking on "View eBill" after logging into Your Connection. Payments made after this date will be assessed a \$30 Administrative fee for a balance due of \$30 or more.
