1. Monday, October 4 – John Arnold, Assistant Professor, Department of History

“What Happened to French Exceptionalism: France 2010”

Professor Arnold will share his experiences leading a study abroad course to Paris and Normandy. The course, *Heavenly Portals*, was focused around the great medieval cathedrals in northern France. Has the French sense of uniqueness and superiority disappeared?

2. Monday, November 1–Daniela Peterka-Benton, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology and Anthropology

“Radical right wing extremism in Austria: still a current threat?”

Right-wing extremism is certainly not a new phenomenon for Austria. While clearly identifiable right-wing extremist groups (skinheads) seem to have declined, political extremism from the right is gaining more and more support (as experienced in other European nations). This presentation deals with a current update on threats and actual political and criminal developments from Austria's far right.

3. Monday, December 6 – Leanna Greenberg, senior, Department of Psychology

“From Russia, With Love”

Leanna will discuss her study abroad in St. Petersburg, Russia. Included will be favorite locations and excursions from the course, a few of the people that she met, and some of the special opportunities she had as a student of Dr. Jack Croxton.
