### Specific Databases available for Biology include:



#### EbscoHost Databases:

**EBSCO Animals:** Offers in-depth information on a variety of topics relating to animals.

**General Science Collection:** Provides information on all aspects of science.

**GreenFile:** Covers all aspects of human impact to the environment.

**BioOne:** Contains citations and summaries of articles published in over 82 journals focusing on the biological, ecological and environmental sciences.



**ScienceDirect** contains high quality peer reviewed journals from Elsevier publishing journals.



**JSTOR** Provides a comprehensive backfile of major scholarly journals in the Arts and Sciences, Business, Ecology & Botany, General Science, Language & Literature, and Music. Journals are not current, most having a "moving wall" or "embargo" of three to five years, depending on publication.

### Using InterLibrary Loan

**Use InterLibrary Loan** services to acquire materials that are not available at Reed Library or full text online. The library often can get electronic materials in 2 days or less and books in 3-5 days. To learn more about InterLibrary Loan, go to:
