### Specific Databases available for Visual Arts include:



ARTstor is a digital library of nearly one million images in the areas of art, architecture, the humanities, and social sciences with a set of tools to view, present, and manage images for research and pedagogical purposes.



JSTOR contains journals in the humanities and social sciences. Coverage for many journals often begins with the first issue of the journal and contains complete coverage to the end of the journal's "moving wall" (within 1-3 years of current publication)



### EBSCOHost Databases:

**Humanities International Complete:** A collection of peer reviewed journals in the humanities.

**Art Collection:** A subset of Academic Search Premier containing Art Journals

### Oxford Reference Online

Contains many standard reference tools in art and architecture, including the Oxford Dictionary of Art and Artists and the Oxford Companion to Western Art, among others.

### Using InterLibrary Loan

Use InterLibrary Loan services to acquire materials that are not available at Reed Library or full text online. The library often can get electronic materials in 2 days or less and books in 3-5 days. To learn more about InterLibrary Loan, go to:
