

FURTHER EDITORIAL CHANGES PROPOSED BY AMY CUHEL-SCHUCKERS

Line:

- 98 on page 3: Is there still a 'Health, Wellness and Recreation' department?
- 103 on page 4: Should there be a comma behind the word 'Audiology' ?
- 133 on page 4: Should '3. Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs' be dropped below the current line 136, thereby grouping the Associate Vice Presidents below the Vice Presidents?
 - Since there are three Associate VP's in Academic Affairs, should the Associate Vice President for Information Technology be added below the current line 137?
- 147 on page 5: What does the 'University Senator' refer to? Is this, by chance, a duplication of the SUNY Faculty Senator? If not, what position does this refer to?
- 168 on page 5: Should the 'f' of 'fall semester' be capitalized?
- 296 on page 9: Should the 'a' in 'academic or Professional Staff' be capitalized?
- 302 on page 9: Should the phrase 'date of mailing of the minutes' be changed to 'date of posting of the minutes' or something similar since the minutes are no longer mailed?
- 381 on page 12: Should the phrase 'Associate Vice President' be changed to 'Associate Vice Presidents'?
 - Should this phrase more appropriately be placed before the word 'Dean' since a descending order of responsibility is being used?
- 425 on page 13: Should the phrase 'Associate Vice Presidents' be placed before the word 'Dean'?
- 460 on page 14: Should the word 'master's' be capitalized?
- 466 on page 14: Should the word 'Committee' (second from last word in line) be changed to 'Council'?
- 508 on page 15: Should the word 'often' from the previous version of the Bylaws be reinserted into the phrase 'shall be created no more (often) than every'? The word 'often' is kept before the next usage of 'than'.
