Already-Accessible Data

The following data is deposited into the department folder on the shared drive that is accessible only to department chairs and <u>does not need to be requested</u> from IRPA (Institutional Research, Planning, and Assessment):

<u>Course evaluations</u>: (this is available if your department has administered course evaluations using the OpScan forms disseminated by IRPA)

Contribution and consumption reports:

- a. Consumption by major: includes each major code with the associated courses taken for that major with the total credit hours and the percentage. The percentage is based on the total credit hours for each course taken for each major divided by the total credit hours for all courses taken per major.
- b. Contribution by department: includes each department code and the associated majors with the percent of credit hours by department and total credit hours. The percentage is based on the total credit hours for each major within each department divided by the total credit hours for all majors in that department
