
Mac OS X 10.7 and 10.8: Automatically enable 802.1x authentication. Simply connect your computer to the network via Ethernet and OS X will prompt you for your username and password. Enter your Fredonia account credentials and click OK. OS X will remember your credentials so you do not have to authenticate every time you connect.

OS X 10.6 - 10.6.8 Snow Leopard: 802.1x is not enabled by default. To enable this service follow these instructions:


1. Open "System Preferences" and click on "Network"




2. Click on "Ethernet" and then "Advanced"




3. Click on "802.1x" and then the "+" sign and select "Add User Profile"



4. Type your name in the box



5. Enter your Fredonia e-Services ID and password, make sure ONLY "PEAP" is checked and click "ok"



6. Plug in your Ethernet cable, click on "Connect" and then Click "Apply"
