It has been reported that five persons were killed and at least 19 injured in this very sad incident. My prayers are with the victims and their families.

Situations like this reinforce my firm belief that violence and hate have no place in our society, including hate directed at members of the LGBTQ+ community. These tragedies remind us of how important it is to be concerned about the welfare of others and strive for a more inclusive and just society. Hence, I urge our community to remember those who were killed and injured in ways that are supportive and uplifting.
