Dear Fredonia campus community,

I believe that you have heard about the recent mass shootings in California: Monterey Park on January 21, 2023 with 11 people killed and; in Half Moon Bay on January 23, 2023 with 7 killed. In these two incidents, 18 people lost their lives horribly and senselessly. According to reports, the Monterey Park victims were mostly people of Asian descent and the Moon Bay victims were farm workers of both Asian descent and Hispanic descent. My heart goes out to the victims and their families. My prayers are with them and I urge our community to remember them in ways that are supportive and uplifting.

Although these deaths and the physical injuries occurred hundreds of miles away from us here in Fredonia, I know that our community is one that empathizes with the human condition regardless of how far away it may occur. As such, I believe we are impacted by the pain, sufferings, fears, and anxieties people in the two California communities are feeling as a result of these tragedies. So, I am thinking of you and want to encourage you to take some time to care for yourself and offer support to others if you are able.
