Each State agency has an ongoing obligation to comply with the law and to train its employees on Project Sunlight, including re-training every two years of all personnel who may be Decision Makers and/or Advisors.

We appreciate your assistance in helping SUNY Fredonia become and remain compliant with this law enacted by the Governor as part of the Omnibus Ethics Legislation. The following has been communicated to each campus:

- > Willful failure to report as required by Project Sunlight may result in disciplinary action
- > Follow-up with individual campuses will take place if the Project Sunlight website reflects a lower than expected level of actual Project Sunlight appearances
