- > For non-native English speakers: TOEFL* non-aggregated minimum scores of

reading 22, listening 22, speaking 26, writing 24 (total minimum TOEFL score 94)

(*IELTS scores of approximate equivalence: reading 6.5, listening 6.5, speaking 7.0, writing 7.0) (TOEFL 94 = IELTS Overall Band Score 7.0)
