Admission Requirements

Requirements for admission to the **Educational Leadership** program are:

- Valid New York State Education Department (NYSED) teaching certification or equivalent in a core area
- Master's degree in education or related field with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Three years of satisfactory teaching or professional experience in a PreK-12 school or its equivalent
- Evidence of completion of DASA training* for New York State
- Two written recommendations, one each from the applicant's
 - district superintendent and
 - o immediate supervisor
- A completed <u>graduate application</u> for summer term**
