

## Advanced Certificate in Educational Leadership

### Admission Requirements

Requirements for admission to the [Educational Leadership](#) program are:

- Valid New York State Education Department (NYSED) teaching certification or equivalent in a core area
- Master's degree in education or related field with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Three years of satisfactory teaching or professional experience in a PreK-12 school or its equivalent
- Evidence of completion of DASA training\* for New York State
- Two written recommendations, one each from the applicant's
  - district superintendent and
  - immediate supervisor
- A completed [graduate application](#) for **summer term**\*\*
