- ~ CDS encourages each student to create a course schedule balanced with requirements and desired electives.
- ~ Each student must complete a minimum of 66 credit hours of courses outside the major & major requirements.
- ~ Each student must complete a minimum of 45 credits in 300- to 400-level (upper level) courses.
- ~ CDS requires two Natural science courses: a Biology and Physical Science. Consult CDS guidelines and advisor prior to enrolling.
- ~ Each student must complete a minimum of one Foreign Language course at 110-level or higher. ASL 110 is one option.
- ~ Maximum of four credit hours of 100-level Physical Education courses will count toward the 120 required for graduation.
- ~ Recommended Minors: *Psychology, Foreign Language, Public Health, English,* or any discipline of a genuine interest.
- ~ Go to Degree Works, via *Your Connection*, to verify your level of program completion.
