- ~ CDS requires two Natural science courses: a Biology and Physical Science. Consult CDS guidelines and advisor prior to enrolling.
- ~ Foreign Language: Sign Language fulfills this for the CDS major, as will any Fredonia Foundations approved sequence.
- ~ Maximum of four credit hours of 100-level Physical Education courses will count toward the 120 required for graduation.
- ~ Recommended Minors: *Psychology, Foreign Language, Public Health, English,* or any discipline of a genuine interest.
- ~ Go to Degree Works (via Your Connection) to verify your level of program completion.
