

<u>CHI ALPHA EPSILON HONOR SOCIETY INDUCTION</u> <u>TO BE HELD MARCH 13, 2013</u>

Wednesday, March 13, the <u>Educational Development Program (EDP)</u> and the <u>Full</u> <u>Opportunity Program (FOP)</u> at the State University of New York at Fredonia will be inducting six new members into the Alpha Mu chapter of <u>Chi Alpha Epsilon</u> (XAE), a national honor society for opportunity program students.

XAE was formed to recognize the academic achievement of students admitted to colleges and universities through non-traditional criteria/opportunity programs. Dr. Elbert M. Saddler, Ph.D., founded Chi Alpha Epsilon in 1990 at West Chester University of Pennsylvania and there are now over 110 chapters in the United States. Eligible students must be full-time and hold a 3.0 cumulative GPA for two consecutive semesters.
