TUITION AND FEES

We currently require international undergraduate and graduate students to document approximately \$32,000 to cover the cost of tuition, fees, room and board for their first academic year of study. This documentation allows the applicant to be eligible for a form I-20.

UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

HONORS PROGRAM

International undergraduate applicants are able to apply for the Fredonia Honors Program. Admitted students will be considered for a \$1,500 onetime award.

GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS

Graduate students may apply for a graduate assistantship upon acceptance into one of our graduate programs. Graduate assistantships are usually posted between March and April on Fredonia's Human Resources website. Full assistantships cover 18 credit hours/year at the New York State tuition rate (approx \$9,400), plus a \$6,700/year stipend.
