


- You will start taking credit courses sooner than traditional English programs. Our summer term allows you to complete 3 semesters every year.

- You will have multiple opportunities for out of classroom experiences, including internships, research, volunteer, and professional job shadowing.









A TOEFL or IELTS is perferred. Please send your official score card to intlrecruit@fredonia.edu once you have completed your application.

TESTING ON ARRIVAL

All students will be tested during orientation. If the placement test is substantially different than the scores submitted for acceptance, the Pathway duration will be affected.

ONLINE PLACEMENT

An online placement test is available for students who do not have an official English score; however, some Visa officers may be less likely to approve a Visa without a TOEFL or IELTS score.

Changing/Shortening Pathways

SHORTEN

Revised English Proficiency scores are accepted up until the first day of orientation, after which no adjustments will be made to pathway placement using external test scores.

MORE CREDITS

High performing students may be permitted to take additional credits during their pathway.

MORE ENGLISH

All students taking less than 20 hours of English per week are able to opt-in to additional paid English courses if they want more support.

DIRECT

If a student recieves a TOEFL or IELTS score that meets full-admissions (79/6.5)before the end of their pathway, they may transfer to their degree program.

APROXIMATE NUMBER OF TOTAL STUDENTS IN ALL 80+ UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE MAJORS







APROXIMATE NUMBER OF TOTAL INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS








About Fredonia
