



Study Abroad Scholarship Application Form

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for OIE scholarships, applicants must:

- Be a full-time Fredonia student in good academic standing
- Meet all requirements and prerequisites for the chosen study abroad program and/or scholarship(s) they are applying for
- Display a strong interest in international study
- Submit complete applications (no partial applications will be considered)

A committee comprised of Fredonia faculty and staff will review applications and select scholarship recipients. Applications will be reviewed based on the following criteria:

- A strong relationship between the student's study abroad program and their future goals
- The student's plan to share their experience with the Fredonia campus upon their return
- Student's campus/community involvement prior to studying abroad

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS/DEADLINE

Applicants should submit the Study Abroad Application form, personal statement, and official transcript to the Office of International Education, 7 LoGrasso Hall no later than:

October 30 for J-Term/Spring Study Abroad

March 20 for Summer/Fall Study Abroad
