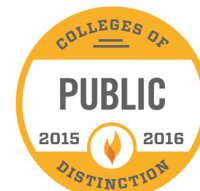

HOW TO APPLY

The easiest, fastest and most secure way to apply is online using the SUNY Application or the Common Application. Choose one or the other, but please do not submit both. The fee for applying is \$50/application.

1. Official Academic Transcripts
2. TOEFL or IELTS score
3. Copy of Passport
4. Form FSA4 and Financial Documentation
5. Transfer applicants should provide university transcripts and transcript evaluation through an NACES accredited service (<http://www.naces.org/members.html>) for any college courses taken outside of the United States.

TUITION AND FEES

We currently require international applicants to document \$32,000 for their first year of room, board, tuition, fees and meal plan in order to be eligible for the I20.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

For full admission, students ask our applicants to prove their proficiency in English. We require students to have a TOEFL score of 79 OR an IELTS score of 6.5 OR have 30 credit hours from a college within the United States. For students who do not meet our minimum test score, Fredonia offers conditional admissions without a TOEFL or IELTS score through our on campus EC English Intensive program. EC English Language Center at Fredonia provides a unique full immersion language study in an American university setting; students have the opportunity to live on campus while they improve their language skills. SCHOLARSHIPS

Fredonia offers approximately \$3 million in merit and need based scholarships to academically qualified new and returning students each year.
