# **TUITION AND FEES**

We currently require international applicants to document \$32,000 for their first year of room, board, tuition, fees and meal plan in order to be eligible for the I20.

# **ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS**

For full admission, students ask our applicants to prove their proficiency in English. We require students to have a TOEFL score of 79 OR an IELTS score of 6.5 OR have 30 credit hours from a college within the United States. For students who do not meet our minimum test score, Fredonia offers conditional admissions without a TOEFL or IELTS score through our on campus EC English Intensive program. EC English Language Center at Fredonia provides a unique full immersion language study in an American university setting; students have the opportunity to live on campus while they improve their language skills.
