Student Absences



2 DAYS OR LESS

- When a student notifies faculty of an absence that impacts only 1-2 days, alternate coursework arrangements are at the discretion of faculty.
- Faculty should not request or take possession of any medical documentation. Student Affairs does not provide notification for absences less than 3 days.
- For students who exhibit a pattern of repeated absences, faculty are encouraged to raise Starfish flags and refer students for assistance/support as appropriate.

3 OR MORE CONSECUTIVE DAYS

- For absences that impact 3+ consecutive days, students are encouraged to submit documentation to Student.Affairs@fredonia.edu
- Student Affairs will notify faculty/student's advisors via
 Starfish of documented absences that impact 3+ consecutive days.
- Alternate coursework arrangements are at the discretion of the faculty.
- Note that depending on the nature of the absence, some students may be able to complete coursework even while they are unable to attend class.
