What goes on at this event?

- University tables are organized, mostly in alphabetical order. (featuring FREDONIA graduate programs)
- ♦ 1-2 representatives, sometimes a Fredonia graduate, will be at the table with brochures, application directions, and giveaways (pens, magnets, frisbees, etc.).
- There is typically little-to-no wait time to speak with the rep.
- ◆ Ask questions about the university, program, application, scholarships/fellowships, etc.
- Visit as many or as few tables as you wish.

Why should I attend?

Regardless of class year and major, all are welcome to attend.

University representatives WANT to meet students/candidates and share unique details about their program and university experience. Create personal connections with university reps to personalize your application.

There are multiple reasons to attend the Graduate School Fair:

- Your career requires an advanced graduate degree.
- ◆ Identify IF and HOW an advanced degree can enhance career options, and advancement opportunities.
- Ask general questions, and more specific questions. The reps are more than happy to accept ANY questions!
- Begin graduate program research in advance to know what's in store for the application process.



What kind of questions should I ask?

Consider details important to you from an academic, personal and professional and perspective. Typical asked questions might include learning details about...

- the application process
- career possibilities and outcomes
- the curriculum, including internships
- research opportunities
- graduate assistantships and financial aid deadlines
- housing options
- \bullet accommodations and accessibility
- general qualifications for admission (grades, extracurriculars, majors, etc.)
